A DORATION

Why do **you** prize and admire, love and cherish the Lord? Scripture will always help remind us as we tend to forget and thus minimize who He is. Take a moment to pause and gain perspective, then adore the Creator and Sustainer of all things, who will one day judge the world.

*Need some help? Read **Colossians 1:15-20, Revelation 4, 5.***

C ONFESSION

Confess your **faith** to God. Tell Him what you believe. The Lord is honored and worshiped when we confess that we believe His words. Confess your **sins** (be specific). Don't let your sin stockpile up! Be quick to confess, and afterwards be met with forgiveness because of Jesus.

*Need some help? Read **1 Corinthians 15:1-4** out loud, then read **Psalm 32:1-5.***

T HANKSGIVING

We have so much to be thankful for. The promises of God are secure and fully trustworthy. Do you know them? Believe them(!) and don't forget to say, “Thank you!” when you recognize His loving hand upon you.

*Need some help? Read **Psalm 100, 107:8-9, 136; 1 Chronicles 16:8-12;** then consider God's will in Christ Jesus for you in **1 Thessalonians 5:16-18.***

S UPPLICATION

Talk to God about your needs and the needs of others. Pray for the lost world, pray for authorities, pray with intensity, ask in faith. Believe He exists and rewards those who earnestly seek Him.

*Need some help? Read **Matthew 6:8,11; Psalm 107:6,13,19-20; 28:1-2, Hebrews 11:6.***
